



BOARD AND LEADERSHIP TEAM DECISION ON MAJOR EXPENDITURES

The Board and Leadership Team met on 9/15/20 to discuss the neighborhood feedback and decide what action to take. In attendance were Brian Ash, Karl Kime, Matt Mawdsley, Nelson Knapp, Carrie Butler, Rob Snelling and Christy Snelling.

After discussing the neighborhood feedback, answering questions and debating the pros and cons of each item and how much to spend, there was a unanimous vote to install security cameras at all three entrances to Ravenwood South and purchase one radar sign per year for the next 2-3 years depending on how effective they are.

We plan to get our own signs made to be installed on the poles with the security cameras.

We will initiate a contract with the City to purchase the radar signs from them at cost in exchange for the City maintaining them.

The first radar sign will be installed on Glenhaven. Radar signs in years 2 and 3 will likely be on either Nottingham or Norshire.

Matt Mawdsley will take the lead on getting the security cameras installed and Rob Snelling will take the lead on getting the radar signs installed.

While we know that any decision that we made would not have unanimous support, we appreciate the hard work that everyone has put into researching the various options and providing their feedback.

This was a big decision and we feel confident that we've done everything we can to be open and transparent about the process.
